Archie E. MacLeod; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$613 from the general highway fund to be paid to Archie E. MacLeod, of Orrington, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his well caused by road construction.
