## AN ACT Relating to Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 74, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 74 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 9. Receipts and disbursements. The secretary of the board shall receive and account for all moneys derived under the provisions of this chapter, and shall pay the same, as provided by law, to the treasurer of state, who shall keep such moneys in a separate fund to be known as the "professional engineers' fund." The secretary of the board shall receive a such salary and allowance for clerical hire as recommended by the board shall determine, in addition to the expenses provided for in section 5. The board may make other expenditures from this fund, upon itemized vouchers approved by the chairman of the board which in the opinion of the board are reasonably necessary for the proper performance of its duties under the provisions of this chapter.'
