AN ACT Appropriating Funds from the Maine Post War Public Works Reserve for Certain State Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Funds for certain state departments. There is hereby appropriated, from the Maine post war public works reserve, for the purposes and in the amounts as follows:
