**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE**

**AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Rumford Falls
Municipal Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1907, c. 429, § 1, amended. The 1st sentence of section 1 of chapter 429 of the private and special laws of 1907, as amended by chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1929, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘From and after the 1st day of July, 1907, the judge of the Rumford Falls municipal court, shall receive an annual salary of ~~two thousand dollars~~ \$2,200, payable quarterly out of the county treasury of the county of Oxford, on the 1st days of July, October, January and April, which shall be in full payment for his services as such judge.’
