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### **AN ACT Amending the Unemployment Compensation Act as to Employer's Experience Classifications.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 24, § 7, sub-§ (d), ¶ (2), sub-¶ (E), amended.** Sub-paragraph (E) of paragraph (2) of subsection (d) of section 7 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(E) 1.5% if his contributions credited exceed his benefits charged by an amount equivalent to or greater than 12.5% of his average annual pay roll for the 36-consecutive-months period ending on the computation date and such excess is less than 15% of such average annual pay roll.’

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 24, § 7, sub-§ (d), ¶ (2), amended.** Paragraph (2) of subsection (d) of section 7 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding a new sub-paragraph to be lettered (F) to read as follows:

‘(F) 1.2% if his contributions credited exceed his benefits charged by an amount equivalent to or greater than 15% of his average annual pay roll for the 36-consecutive-months period ending on the computation date.’
