IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Maximum Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 11, § 4-A, additional. Chapter 11 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 4-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 4-A. Non-contributory pensions, limitation. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no person, who has received or may receive a non-contributory pension from the state, shall receive a pension of more than \$1,200 per year.'
