RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Cherryfield.

Town of Cherryfield; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Cherryfield, the sum of \$5,000 to be paid from the general fund for the purpose of constructing a dam at Stillwater on the Narraguagus river.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are two bridges over the Narraguagus river and also state highway No. 1 which are in great danger of being washed away by flood waters unless a dam is erected.
