STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Create a Commission to Study the Atlantic Salmon.

Commission to study the Atlantic salmon. Resolved: That the president of the senate and the speaker of the house be, and hereby are, authorized to appoint a commission, to consist of 3 citizens of Maine, to study and form of bills or otherwise, as in its judgment may be advisable; and be it further

Resolved: That such commission make a factual report on such studies to the 93rd legislature including therein such recommendations, in the form of bills or otherwise, as in its judgment may be available; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$7,500 to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Atlantic salmon is no longer plentiful and it is necessary to make a study of the situation in order to preserve and restore such salmon.
