### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Greenville to Correct Height of Overpass of the Canadian Pacific Railroad at Greenville Junction.

Town of Greenville; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$2,500 for the purpose of correcting the height of the overpass of the Canadian Pacific railroad at Greenville Junction, which overpass crosses state highway No. 15, and be it further

**Resolved:** That the expenditure of such funds shall be under the control and supervision of the highway commission.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The overpass of the Canadian Pacific railroad at Greenville Junction which crosses state highway No. 15 is not high enough to allow clearance for large trucks. It is necessary for such trucks to pass over private property in order to travel around the overpass and such conditions should be corrected.
