STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Salem for Forest Fire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Salem; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$547.85, to be paid to the town of Salem to reimburse such town for money expended in extinguishing a forest fire which occurred in August, 1944, said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Salem cannot pay the entire cost of fighting forest fire because of its present financial condition, which is such that the town is not asking to be deorganized. The total cost of the forest fire in August, 1944 to the town of Salem was \$1,659.09.
