# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Estate of R. Byron Flewelling, Late of West Gardiner, Deceased; for Damage to Property.

Estate of R. Byron Flwelling; compensated for loss of property. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3,500 to be paid to Adaline B. Flewelling of Gardiner, as administratrix of the Estate of R. Byron Flewelling, late of West Gardiner, deceased, as a full and final settlement against the state, for loss of certain personal property caused by fire, which fire was set by Elgra O. Ryder of Clinton, a minor ward of the state; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 14, 1943, the farm of R. Byron Flewelling was set on fire by a state ward. The buildings and contents were destroyed. Part of the loss was covered by insurance, but there was no insurance on the articles in the barn.
