STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry K. Morey of Deer Isle.

Henry K. Morey; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$850 to be paid to Henry K. Morey of Deer Isle, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his property caused by the state highway commission raising the road in front of his house; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state highway commission raised the road in front of Mr. Morey's home causing water to flow over his lawn and into his cellar, damaging and cracking the cement floor and foundation.
