STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Bragdon Wild Life Sanctuary and the Wells and Kennebunk Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 90, 5th and 6th ¶¶, repealed. The 5th and 6th paragraphs of section 90 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, relating to Bragdon Wild Life Sanctuary, are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 90, amended. That part of section 90 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes which relates to Wells and Kennebunk game preserve is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Wells and Kennebunk: The following described tract, or territory, situated in the towns town of Wells and Kennebunk, in the county of York, to wit:

A certain tract of land consisting of 2,500 acres, more or less, bounded and described as follows: On the east by the Atlantic ocean; on the south by the Drake island road, so called; on the west by the Atlantic Shore Highway U. S. Number I Highway, so called; on the north by the Mousam river town line of Kennebunk and Wells.'
