STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Irving Crockett, of Durham.

Irving Crockett; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$175 from the appropriation for the department of agriculture to be paid to Irving Crockett, of Durham, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to 4 heifers by dogs, said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This damage occurred about the middle of July, 1944, the 4 heifers being a complete loss after being badly injured and chewed by dogs.
