RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold Harvey and Henry Marsh of Corinth.

Harold Harvey and Henry Marsh; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$327 to be paid to Harold Harvey and Henry Marsh of Corinth, as a full and final settlement for their claim against the state for sheep killed by bears; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the fall of 1944, 25 purebred sheep were killed by bears. This claim has been reported to the department of agriculture.
