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**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Repair Fish Way at Aroostook Falls.**

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**Fish way at Aroostook Falls; repairing of. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,000 to be taken from the general fund of the state and expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, for repairing the fish way at Aroostook Falls on the Aroostook river in the Province of New Brunswick; said fish way to be repaired at the time said money, workmen and materials shall be available.

Any and all acts done in compliance with the provisions of this resolve in the Province of New Brunswick shall be with the consent and approval of said Province.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The reason for this expenditure is because of the fact that the present fish way has given away and in order for efficient use and to serve its purpose it must be repaired.
