STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Dr. Charles H. Buck of Naples.

Dr. Charles H. Buck; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$187.50 to be paid to Dr. Charles H. Buck of Naples, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to poultry by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Dr. Buck lost 150 hens valued at \$1.25 each which were killed by foxes during the season of 1944. The damage was reported to a game warden.
