RESOLVE, in Favor of the Estate of R. Byron Flewelling, Late of West Gardiner, Deceased; for Loss of Life.

Estate of R. Byron Flewelling, deceased; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Adaline B. Flewelling, of Gardiner, as administratrix of the estate of R. Byron Flewelling, late of West Gardiner, deceased, as a full and final settlement against the state, for the death of said R. Byron Flewelling, who was burned to death in a fire in a barn located on his farm in said West Gardiner, which fire was set by Elgra O. Ryder of Clinton, a minor ward of the state; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 14, 1943, the farm of R. Byron Flewelling was set on fire by a state ward, in which fire Mr. Flewelling lost his life. There was no insurance on Mr. Flewelling's life.
