RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles B. Buck of Newfield.

Charles B. Buck; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$245 to be paid Charles B. Buck of Newfield for 245 pullets valued at \$1 each, killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

These pullets were killed over a period from around the 1st of June through to the latter part of October.

This Resolve is presented at the suggestion of S. F. Dorrance, Livestock Specialist, as it cannot be paid under the present law.
