STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Roy Marshall of Sanford.

Roy Marshall; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$300 to be paid to Roy Marshall of Sanford, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his chickens and roosters by fox or foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This damage was done from July 1 to October 3, 1944. The farm is in Sanford where the damage occurred.
