**AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of Certain County Officials in Knox
County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of the 1st paragraph of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the clerk of courts in Knox county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Knox, ~~\$2,200~~ \$2,400.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the sheriff of Knox county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Knox, ~~\$1,500~~ \$2,000.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of the 2nd paragraph of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the judge of probate in Knox county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Knox, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,200.'
