AN ACT Relating to Control of Deer in Acadia National Park.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Control of deer in Acadia National Park. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby instructed to make a study of the deer situation in Acadia National Park and on Mt. Desert island in conjunction with the National Park Service of the Department of the Interior, and to report the result of their findings together with such remedial measures as they recommend to the 93rd legislature.
