RESOLVE, in Favor of William A. Johnson of Orrington.

William A. Johnson; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$720 to be paid to William A. Johnson of Orrington as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine for damage to poultry by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Foxes caused the loss of 800 poultry from the age of 6 weeks to 6 months, at an average of 90 cents each.
