STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to Daily Bag Limit from Androscoggin Watershed above Middle Dam.

Daily bag limit from Androscoggin watershed. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting the daily bag limit, unless otherwise restricted, to 6 fish per person per day in the aggregate from all waters in the Kennebago watershed above the Oquossoc Light and Power Company dam on the Kennebago river.
