IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Advertise and Sell Certain Stumpage in the Town of Ashland.

Forest commissioner authorized to advertise and sell certain stumpage. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise and sell certain stumpage on lots 45 and 48 in the north part of Sheridan, now a part of the town of Ashland; and be it further

Resolved: That the selling price shall not be less than the market price for stumpage prevailing in Aroostook County; and be it further

Resolved: That the proceeds of such sale shall constitute a separate fund to be used by the forest commissioner for the purpose of locating other public lots which have never been sold or apportioned.
