AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the County Offices in Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to Knox county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Knox county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$1,040~~ \$1,560; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$832~~ \$1,560; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, ~~\$1,040~~ \$1,560; for clerk hire in the office of the office of the county treasurer, \$180. The salaries of these clerks in the county offices of Knox county shall obtain until 90 days after the end of the first regular session of the legislature which shall convene after the termination of the war.'
