AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in County Offices in Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the county offices in Sagadahoc county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sagadahoc county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$1,560~~ \$1,950; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$1,040~~ \$1,300; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, ~~\$1,040~~ \$1,300.'

Sec. 2. Limitation of act. This act shall remain in force for a period of 2 years only. It is the intent of the legislature to change the present statute for a period of 2 years only, after which period the present statute shall return to full force and effect.
