STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing Towns to Cooperate with Highway Commission in Maintaining Town Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, amended. Chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 23-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 23-A. Cooperation with highway commission authorized. Towns are authorized to enter into agreements with the state highway commission for the expenditure of town funds for maintenance and repair of town roads; and the state highway commission is authorized, when requested by towns, to accept town funds for expenditure under its direction.'
