STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Create a Commission to Study the Atlantic Salmon.

Commission to study the Atlantic salmon. Resolved: That the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized to appoint 3 competent persons to constitute a commission to make a study and survey of conditions affecting the Atlantic salmon, and recommend the necessary steps to be taken to rehabilitate the Atlantic salmon as a food and game fish in Maine waters; and be it further

Resolved: That said commission shall complete their work and file their final report with the governor to be by him transmitted to the 93rd legislature; and be it further

Resolved: That the members of the said commission shall receive \$10 per diem and expenses when engaged in the discharge of their official duties; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$7,500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
