**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Wallagrass Plantation for Support of the
Family of Edward Berube.**

Wallagrass plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That the state controller be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off from the books of the state the sum of \$1,122.27, now charged to Wallagrass plantation for support of the family of Edward Berube.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Wallagrass plantation has taken care of the family of Edward Berube, who is in the armed forces and cannot be located. The mother has left the children who are under the custody of the department of health and welfare. Wallagrass plantation has appropriated \$2500 for pauper support for 1944-1945 which has been spent for other cases and has no further money to pay this amount to the state.
