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**RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Land for the Pownal State School.**

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**Purchase of land for Pownal state school. Resolved:** That the commissioner of institutional service, with the approval of the governor and council, be authorized to purchase approximately 110 acres of land and the buildings thereon, in the town of New Gloucester, for use of the Pownal state school; such purchase price to be paid from the appropriation for the Pownal state school.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

This property, known as the Wallace Morrill farm, located in the town of New Gloucester, is in very close proximity to the Pownal State School, which would make it a valuable acquisition to that institution, not only for the farm land, but for the possible expansion of the institution in the future and to prevent the possibility of it being acquired by other interests.
