AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Attorney-General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 1, amended. The 6th sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 1 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The attorney-general shall have an office in the state capitol and shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$5,000~~ \$6,000 in full for all services and in lieu of all fees.’
