STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Adjutant-General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 12, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 12 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The adjutant-general shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,500~~ **\$5,500**; he shall receive no other fee, emolument, or perquisite. **The provisions of this act shall remain in effect for the period of 2 years, after which period the present statute shall return to full force and effect.**’
