## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Grant Permits for Setting and Maintaining Poles and Wires on a Public School Lot in Webster Plantation.

Forest commissioner authorized to grant certain permits. Resolved: That the forest commissioner is hereby authorized to grant a permit to Kingman Electrical Company to set and maintain such poles and wires on the public school lot in Webster Plantation, in the county of Penobscot, being located on the southwest side of the Webster-Springfield state aid highway, as may be necessary to enable Kingman Electrical Company to furnish electric service to the occupants of land on the Pickle Ridge road in said plantation, upon such terms and conditions as he may prescribe.
