AN ACT Relating to Hours of Labor for State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 59, § 24, additional. Chapter 59 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 24, to read as follows:

'Sec. 24. Hours of labor for state employees in certain state institutions. No state employee in the classified service in the following state institutions: Augusta state hospital, Bangor state hospital, Pownal state school and the Maine state prison shall be employed over 48 hours per week, unless compensated by additional salary to be determined by the state personnel board.'
