**RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Construction at the Augusta State
Hospital.**

Certain construction at Augusta state hospital. Resolved: That the sum of \$230,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the construction of:

Fireproofing Sanborn building	\$130,000
Fireproofing female pavilion	85,000
Installing sprinkler system in the administration, central and mechanical buildings	15,000
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	\$230,000

at the Augusta state hospital.

This appropriation shall not lapse and shall be carried forward from year to year until such time as the buildings are constructed and the work completed.

This construction shall begin as soon as practicable and prudent, contingent upon the availability of materials and labor and upon such conditions and restrictions as the governor and council may from time to time prescribe.
