RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold Kromer, of LaGrange.

Harold Kromer; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$25 to be paid to Harold Kromer, of La-Grange, as a full and final settlement of all claims for damage to his car by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on August 23, 1942, in Alton route 155, and was investigated by game warden F. W. Sprague. The extent of the damage to Mr. Kromer's car is as follows: right head and parking lights broken, right front fender and hood bent, radiator grill destroyed beyond repair.
