**RESOLVE, in Favor of the University of Maine.**

---

**University of Maine; appropriation for. Resolved:** That, in order to provide funds for emergencies arising out of the problem of providing additional facilities for veterans' education at the University of Maine, there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$250,000 to be made available to the University of Maine until July 1, 1947 upon requisition supported by vote of its board of trustees, said board to be the judge of the emergency.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Whatever the legislature in special session may decide with respect to dealing with increasing enrollment at the University of Maine, additional funds may be needed before the next legislature can act. It is believed that the amount needed for increased operating expenses will be considerably less if the recommendation of the trustees for immediate construction of dormitories on campus is adopted, as compared to probable expense of a longer term operation off-campus. This resolve is introduced as a basis for legislative consideration. The determination of exact amount to be appropriated should await the decision on the other University of Maine proposals.
