**AN ACT Waiving Certain Requirements for Veterans in State
Employment.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 59, § 12-A, amended. Section 12-A of chapter 59 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 360 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘In determining qualifications for examination, appointment, promotion, retention, transfer or reinstatement with respect to preference eligibles under this section, the personnel board or other examining agency shall waive requirements as to age, height and weight, provided any such requirement is not essential to the performance of the duties of the position for which examination is given. The personnel board or other examining agency, after giving due consideration to the recommendation of any accredited physician, shall waive the physical requirements in the case of any veteran, provided such veteran is, in the opinion of the personnel board or other examining agency, physically able to discharge efficiently the duties of the position for which the examination is given.’
