STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 48, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 48 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No license shall be issued to any person under #5 18 years of age, except that junior operators' licenses may be issued to minors who have reached the age of 16 years, but who have not reached 18 years of age; provided, however, that such license shall entitle a licensee to operate a motor vehicle, except a commercial vehicle during the day time only.'
