STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Dorothy L. Springer, of Lisbon Falls.

Teacher's pension granted to Dorothy L. Springer. Resolved: That a special pension be, and hereby is, granted to Dorothy L. Springer, of Lisbon Falls, comparable with that paid under the teachers' noncontributory pension law, based on 25 years of teaching service, as is now or may hereafter be provided by the legislature, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Dorothy Springer has taught in the public schools of Maine for a period of 35 years. She last taught in 1939 and is now applying for a teacher's pension under the provisions of law.
