#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Land in Aroostook County to Maxime F. Albert, of Frenchville.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Maxime F. Albert, of Frenchville, whatever interest the state may have in the following described lots:

- 1. Lot 21 in N. ½ according to plan by Joseph Sewall in 1886. With buildings, 37 acres more or less. (17, R. 4, W. E. L. S., Aroostook).
- 2. Part lot 24 in N. half according to plan of N. half by Joseph Sewall in 1886. With buildings, 37 acres more or less. (17, R. 4, W. E. L. S., Aroostook).

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The first tract of land was sold November 24, 1943 for the 1941 taxes. The second tract was sold November 23, 1932 for the 1930 taxes.

Maxime F. Albert is supposed to have acquired title through foreclosure and wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$447.73, the amount of back taxes, interest and costs, which has been deposited with the state treasurer.
