RESOLVE, in Favor of Arthur Kenney, of Anson.

Arthur Kenney; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$211.60 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Arthur Kenney, of Anson, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 1, 1945, in New Gloucester, and was investigated by Game Warden Francis W. Gill. The car was badly damaged and the insurance carried by Mr. Kenney did not cover this type of accident.
