**RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Molasses Pond in
the Town of Eastbrook.**

Outlet of Molasses pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$400 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the legislative appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Molasses pond in the town of Eastbrook in the county of Hancock; provided, however, that said screen shall not be installed at the outlet of Molasses pond until the town of Eastbrook shall assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The dam at the outlet at Molasses Pond having gone out, the water is lowered to a point where it has become very detrimental to fishing. The property owners on this pond have undertaken to restore the dam and desire that a suitable fish screen be installed at the same time the dam is reconstructed.
