RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Sullivan.

Town of Sullivan; interest charged off. Resolved: That the treasurer of state be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sum of \$523.74, interest on state taxes, now charged against the town of Sullivan for the years 1939 to 1942, inclusive.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Sullivan now owes the state \$523.74 as interest on state taxes. The town of Sullivan was heavily in debt and had no money to pay. The entire principal of the taxes due to the state has been paid by such town.
