RESOLVE, in Favor of Carl Deering, of Buxton.

Carl Deering; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$151.25 to be paid to Carl Deering, of Buxton, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for poultry killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Deering has 121 chickens, valued at \$1.25 each, killed by foxes during the months of May to October of 1945. Total amount of damage is \$151.25.
