## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Members of Boards of Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 3, § 13, amended.** Section 13 of chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 13. Duty of cities in respect to registration. The chairman of the board shall receive \$6 \$8 and the other 2 members of the board shall receive \$5 \$7 each for every day that the board shall be in session for the revision and correction of the voting list and for completing the record thereof. They shall also receive such compensation as may be fixed by the municipal officers for such time as they are necessarily employed in making up and preparing the list of voters, and their necessary expenses. Cities where a board is established shall provide a suitable place for holding its sessions and shall pay for the services of such officers as the board may employ and have in attendance to preserve order and execute its precepts. Such cities shall also pay all reasonable expenses, such as the expense of blank books, stationery, and the necessary assistance of clerks. All witness fees shall be paid at the rates established for municipal courts.'
