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**RESOLVE, in Favor of George D. Craft, of St. John, N. B.**

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**George D. Craft; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$228.41 to be paid to George D. Craft, of 146 Charlotte Street, St. John, N. B., as a full and final settlement of all claims for damage to his car by deer.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident occurred on November 20, 1945, at 1 A. M. in the town of Milbridge and was investigated by Warden Wallace Barron. Mr. Craft's car was being driven by James M. Forestall, 198 Metcalf Street, St. John, N. B., and was damaged to the extent of a bent right fender, broken right headlight lens and bulb, broken radiator grill, broken and punctured radiator, and a bent radiator cowling. To the car damage has been added the sum \$12.50, expenses of the driver necessitated by the 5 days' stop-over in Harrington while the car was being repaired.
