#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of George D. Murray, of York Village.

George D. Murray; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$139.60 from the general fund of the state to be paid to George D. Murray, of York Village, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred in York on June 24, 1945, and was investigated by Game Warden Charles Jones. The car was considerably damaged about the front and left side of the fender, head light, radiator grille, radiator, and hood.
