RESOLVE, in Favor of Guy W. Sheaff, of Weeks Mills.

Guy W. Sheaff; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$112 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Guy W. Sheaff, of Weeks Mills, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his bean crop by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the summer of 1946, deer damaged Mr. Sheaff's bean crop. He estimated his loss to be \$112.
